OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE
NICOLLET COUNTY DRAINAGE AUTHORITY

The Nicollet County Drainage Authority met in regular session on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 9:45 a.m. Commissioners Dehen, Zins, Kolars, Helget, and Dranttel were in attendance. County Administrator Mandy Landkamer and County Attorney Michelle Zehnder were also present.

Approval of Agenda

Motion by Commissioner Kolars and seconded by Commissioner Zins to approve the agenda. Carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda

Motion by Commissioner Dranttel and seconded by Commissioner Helget to approve the consent agenda items follows:

Public Services

Consider the CD61 Improvement Contract Agreement with Ag Tech Drainage

Director Kopet requested approval of the Construction Agreement for the CD61 Improvement with Ag Tech Drainage LLC. The Drainage Authority accepted the bid for CD61 Improvement Project from Ag Tech Drainage LLC on April 14, 2026, in the amount of \$517,750.42.

Motion by Commissioner Zins and seconded by Commissioner Helget to approve the CD61 Improvement Contract Agreement with Ag Tech Drainage LLC. Carried by all voting in favor.

Chair Dehen declared a recess until 10:00 a.m.

Consider Ditch Repair 25-032 - Informational meeting approximately 10:00 a.m.

Nathan Henry, Ditch and Agricultural Inspector, summarized the repair request for the CD76A pump station. Engineer Chris Otterness, Houston Engineering Inc., completed a Repair Feasibility Report for the CD76A pump station repair project. Engineer Otterness has been in contact with several landowners and has issued an additional memorandum, dated April 20, 2026, addressing their questions. A summary of the report and memorandum with offered recommendations regarding the repair of the system was presented to the Drainage Authority.

Gene Dorn – Granby Township

Stated that it was previously mentioned that 3-phase power is available near County Road 5 and could be extended to the site. He understood BENCO to state that they would reduce the cost to extend the 3-phase service to the pump station.

Warren Krohn

Noted his involvement with installing the tractor pump and his experience with the system based upon the amount of rain received.

Seth Krohn

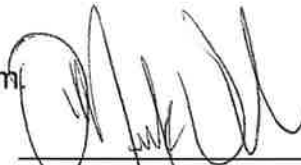
Asks questions about differing pump sizes.

Motion by Commissioner Zins and seconded by Commissioner Helget to authorize the repair of CD76A pump station and approve Houston Engineering Inc.'s Master Service Agreement (MSA) along with CD76A Pump Station Repair Project Task Order and authorize the County Administrator and Property and Public Services Director to execute the Houston Engineering Inc.'s MSA and CD76A Pump Station repair Project Task Order upon final agreement of all terms by the parties.

Carried by all voting in favor.

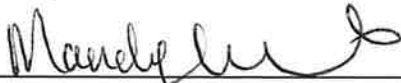
